A recent merger with Smith International has expanded Schlumberger's key services and products to include drill bits, drilling tools, remediation services and drilling fluids. The combination of both companies' technologies serves as a catalyst for delivering more efficient and effective drilling services while reducing risk and optimizing drilling performance and well productivity for customers.
