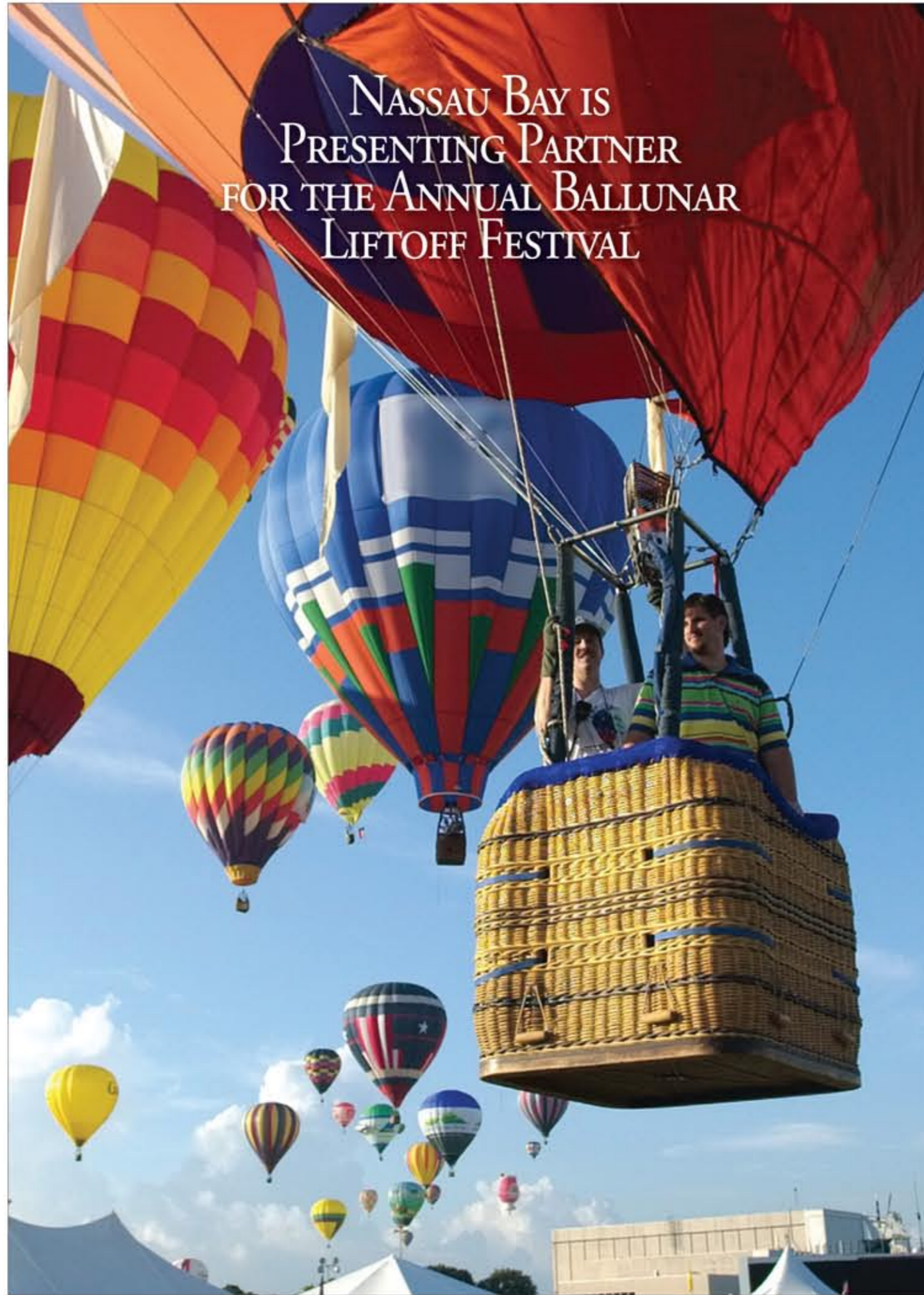
One of the nicest things about Houston is its kaleidoscope of communities – each with a distinct personality. One of the most livable of these communities is Nassau Bay.

Nowhere is Houston's famous can-do attitude more evident than in Nassau Bay – traditional hometown to the astronauts and closest neighbor to the Johnson Space Center. Nassau Bay was developed across from the Johnson Space Center on the old 1776 Ranch property in response to President John F. Kennedy's eloquent call to a heightened commitment to space exploration. Since that time in 1962, our city on Houston's southern border has been home to the space professionals – engineers, administrators, astronomers, astronauts and support teams – who have made America's dreams of exploration and discovery come true.

But that is just one side of Nassau Bay. It is the jewel of Houston's vibrant Bay Area, bordered on two sides by navigable water and one side by a beautiful pristine lake teeming with aquatic and avian life. Clear Creek is a favorite boat channel into Galveston Bay, giving boaters a unique view of coastal marsh before it joins Clear Lake. Clear Lake is the boating recreational center for the entire Houston area. Water skiing, sailing, parasailing, dragon boat races, fishing... it all starts on Clear Lake and Nassau Bay is front and center with a long Clear Lake coastline with spectacular views of all the action. For those who prefer a smaller, quieter lake experience, our own Lake Nassau is one of the most popular birding and wildlife viewing destinations on the Gulf Coast.

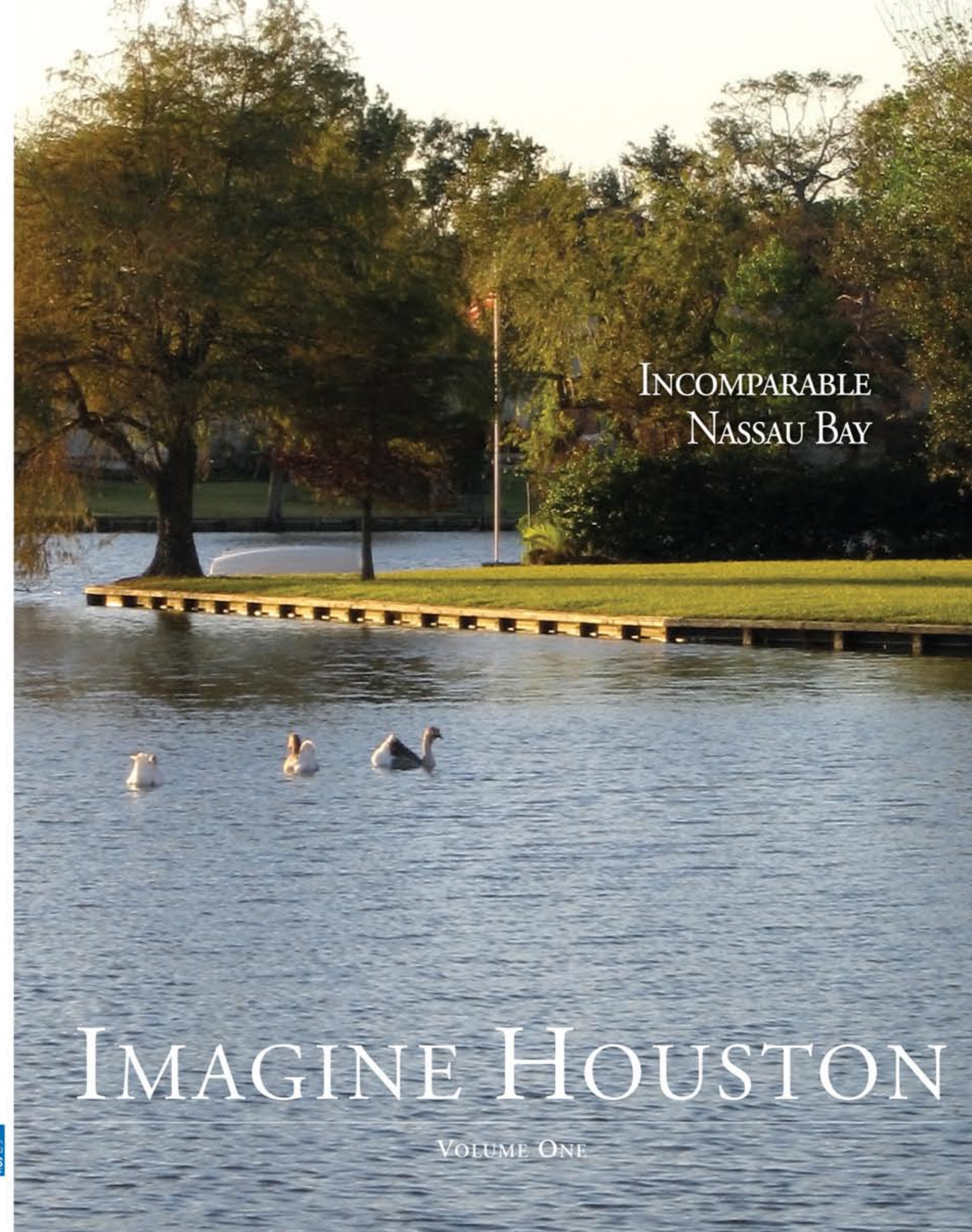

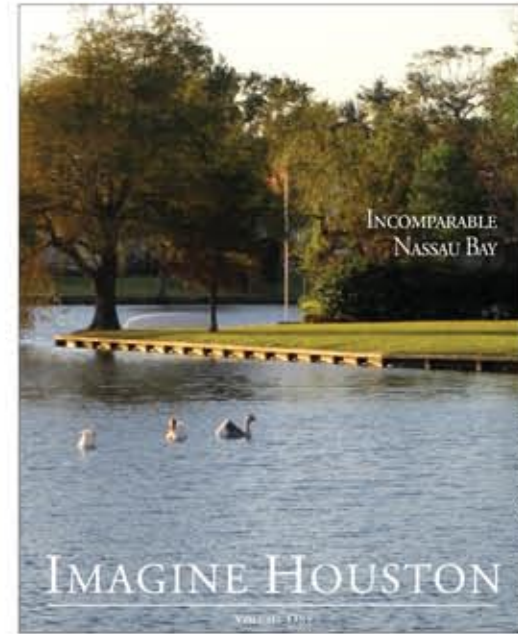
