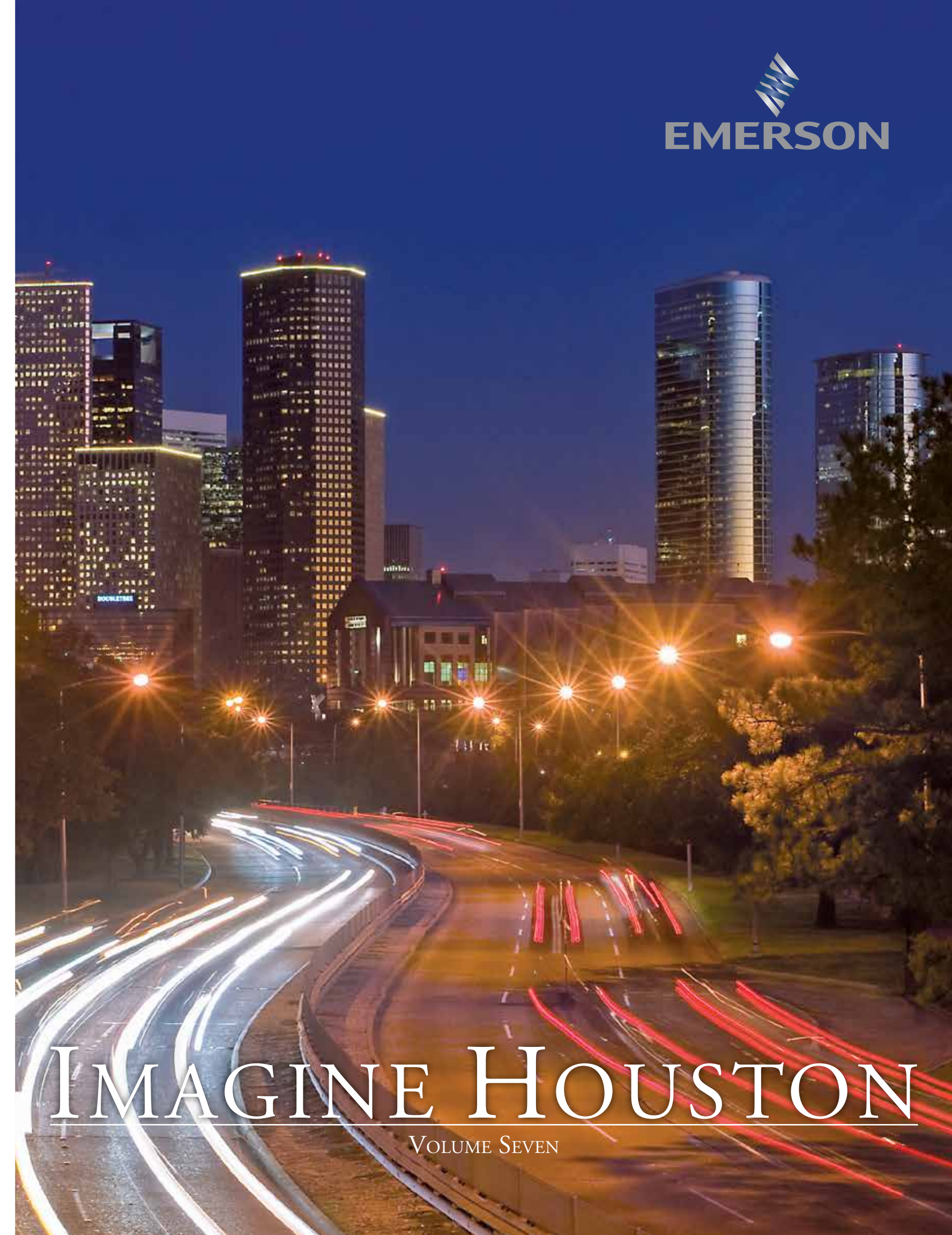

Emerson's Global Industry Center for Hydrocarbon and Energy, representing a \$34 million dollar investment, is staffed with more than 360 employees and is among several manufacturing locations in Houston, including:

- The Americas headquarters for Valve Automation technologies designs and manufactures valve actuators, plans to create more than 125 new jobs and invest \$9.5 million over the coming years to accommodate growth.
- The Daniel Measurement and Control facility has celebrated 82 years of business in Houston and employs more than 450 people who manufacture equipment for oil and gas custody transfer.
- The Rosemount Analytical facility has about 100 employees and manufactures and repairs chromatographs that perform chemical separations to determine the exact make-up of the gas sampled.



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
